Dear Colleagues,

As you will have read from Marc Fisher's [CalMessage](#) late this afternoon, our campus will be closed tomorrow (Wednesday, Oct 9) for non-critical staff due to the [PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff](#).

All employees will be paid and most will not be required to come into work. We are encouraging managers to be flexible with all employees. However, critical employees will be expected to come into work. Employees who are uncertain if they are a critical employee, or if they should report to work, should check with their manager.

Managers are authorized to grant non-critical employees administrative leave during this power outage, which may need to be manually entered and approved in [CalTime](#). For those of you who are deemed critical staff who do have to come into work, please know that we deeply appreciate, value and recognize your contributions in keeping our campus safe and secure.

Early indicators are that the campus outage will last up to 48 hours, but we will monitor conditions and review campus actions as needed. The latest news on campus re-opening will be posted on the [Berkeley News website](#).
